

# What?

The Madison School-Based Health Center is a full service health clinic that provides physical and mental health care to the students of Madison Middle School. We are designed to be "Teen Friendly." The Health Center is operated by Neighborcare Health and partially supported by the Families and Education Levy and the City of Seattle. Neighborcare Health staff work in partnership with the school nurse at each school-based health center site.

# Where?

The Madison School-Based Health Center is located near the entrance to the parking lot on the south side of Madison Middle School.

# Why?

Our purpose is to help students do better in school by working to solve physical and mental health problems, preventing serious illness and promoting healthy lifestyles. We are part of Neighborcare Health, a network of medical, dental and school-based clinics, serving more than 50,000 patients in Seattle each year.

Neighborcare Health is committed to creating a health care home and encouraging long-term relationships between patients and providers that include medical, dental and mental health care.

# When?

The Madison School-Based Health Center is open from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm Monday through Friday. The Center is closed during school holidays and summer break.

When the school-based health centers are closed, students and their families are encouraged to call another Neighborcare Health clinic for medical and dental services. The closest clinic to Madison is Neighborcare Health's High Point Medical & Dental Clinic, 206-461-6950. Students and their families are also welcome at our other Seattle clinics (see back panel).

## What services are offered to students?

### Services offered at the Madison School-Based Health Center include:

- Evaluation and treatment of common health problems
  - Sports physicals
  - Preventive health care
  - Reproductive health care
  - Oral health services
  - Immunizations
  - Individual and group therapy
  - Coordination of care with community providers
  - Crisis intervention
  - Community and school-based referrals
  - Issues we address include: depression, stress, relationship issues, grief & loss, trauma recovery, problem-solving, working on goals
- AND MUCH MORE.



## How do I use the center?

**Register!** Students must be registered with the Madison School-Based Health Center in order to receive care in the Center. A completed registration form with parent or guardian signature is all that is needed to access all of the services offered. Students 18 years old and over can sign registration forms themselves. Under Washington State law, students under 18 can register themselves for confidential care, including reproductive health services and mental health counseling.

Before- and after-school appointments are available. Request to Report slips are given for appointments during school. We will do everything possible to schedule or reschedule so students miss as little class time as possible. Students may also visit the clinic without an appointment by getting a pass from their teacher or when referred by the school nurse.



## What is the cost?

No student will be denied services due to inability to pay. Because the Families and Education Levy covers only a portion of the cost to operate the Madison School-Based Health Center, we bill insurance companies when possible.

For students on Medicaid or a public insurance plan, we bill all services directly and the student/family will have no out-of-pocket expense.

For students with private insurance, it is possible that parents/guardians may have some out-of-pocket cost, depending on the type of services and on the private insurance company's coverage. Not all services are subject to insurance company policies, so please call if you would like more information. Lab services for non-confidential care are billed to the student's private insurance by LabCorp.

Neighborcare Health can assist uninsured or underinsured students and their families with insurance enrollment and have staff who can help with families directly. If a student or family is in need of health care services, including dental care, we have staff available to help.
